Flood support

If your household was affected by the recent flooding, KidsCan may be able to help you replace some household items.

KidsCan's criteria:

- Must be uninsured
- Lost a substantial amount of household items in flooding

KidsCan can help replace the following.

1x Queen and 2x single beds (or bunk beds if preferred – depending on stock availability from the supplier). Washing machine, dryer, fridge, microwave, 2 &/or 3 seater couch, dining table / chairsTV, TV Unit, Tall boy, clothes horse, linen for beds, towels, pillows, cutlery & plates etc, pots / pans, toaster, jug, rice cooker, glasses and cleaning kit (mop, vacuum cleaner, bucket, brush/pan set, broom, disinfectant, wipes etc).

Mobile Library Bus visiting our school

The Auckland Libraries Mobile Library Bus will be again visiting our school and children will get the opportunity to jump aboard and choose 1 or 2 books. It is very exciting for them.

During 2022 if you already have your child signed up as a Library Member they will use this membership to issue a maximum number of 2 items. Children who are not a library member can



be issued with a trial Starter Card where they can borrow 2 items maximum which Auckland Libraries will take responsibility for (you will receive reminders via email or post if items are overdue however there will be no late fees or replacement costs to you). Please help us retain this wonderful service by ensuring your child takes responsibility and returns their books to school or to your local public Library.

Children do not need to bring their card to school and you are welcome to visit your local community Library to use their services or upgrade their card to a full

membership.

Please note that in order for children to have this opportunity we give your child's details to Auckland Libraries. This info will be used for creating the membership card only. Please notify the office if you DON'T wish this to happen. Likewise if your child has an existing membership and you do not wish them to use this card please let us know.



At Chaucer we have several students who are allergic to peanuts and nuts. We ask that parents do not include nutella, peanuts or other nuts, peanut butter or nut bars in your child's school lunch.

This is an increasingly common practice in New Zealand primary schools as allergies to peanuts have increased.

While peanuts are a healthy food for most children they can be extremely dangerous to some children.
