Chaucer School Tiles



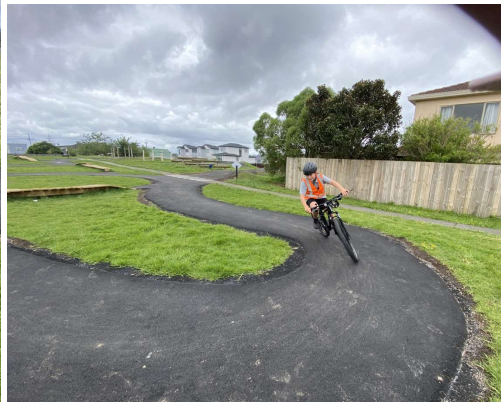
The tiles that our students painted are coming back from firing and they look amazing!
